## What are green parts?

Green parts (also known as recycled or used parts) are original parts, fitted by the manufacturer and reclaimed when a vehicle is dismantled at the end of its life.

Even if a vehicle isn't suitable for repair it will still have lots of undamaged parts in perfect working order.

## Why choose green parts?

### *Get back on the road quicker.*

Like many industries, the motor trade has been hit by supply chain challenges over recent years. Orders for new vehicle parts have been particularly badly affected.

Green parts are often more easily accessible, and choosing one can significantly speed up the repair process.

### *Avoid total loss.*

A vehicle is classed as a total loss or 'write off' when repairing it costs more than the vehicle is worth. The total repair cost includes replacement vehicle costs, so if new parts are expensive with a long delivery time it may be classed as a total loss. Green parts reduce time and cost, avoiding this outcome.

### *Look after the environment.*

When you use a green part you reduce the need for new parts to be manufactured, saving energy and resources.

### *Be sure of a quality repair.*

All the green parts we fit are genuine OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) vehicle parts.

They've been through extensive testing and are tailor-made for your vehicle – you won't be compromising on quality or reliability.

## Are green parts safe?
